Christmas is past, but the Incarnation is still on my mind. The more we learn about the intricacies of the human body at the cellular and subcellular levels, the more we understand that only God could have made it. Recently the mambo (witch/ voodoo priestess) who lives three doors down brought her very sick son to the clinic. We heard afterward that she spent a lot of money on a bokor without success. God used the treatment I gave to produce healing. We took advantage of the visits to witness to the family members. Pastor Thelamour spent extra time with the woman. It takes patience, persistence and prayer to persuade these people that they will truly find liberty through putting their faith in Jesus Christ.

It is always encouraging to hear that a person has trusted Christ. I treated Memsley for stomach problems several years ago. He came to us for similar problems recently, and I heard more of his story. The first time he was sick he had given \$80,000 to a *bokor* for a cure, but to no avail. He came to us, received physical healing (and was stunned by the low cost), heard the good news of salvation through Jesus Christ, and later put trust in Him. Like many other people, Memsley said he was surprised as he looked back and saw how much money he gave to the *bokor* and got nothing in return.

Praise The cholera epidemic seems to be over. It is good that people are much more careful about the water they drink.

The satellite system is now working at the Peart's house. That is a huge blessing!

I just received word from the mission that I am fully supported at this time.

Projects God has graciously provided the medications we need for the clinic.

Prayer We still do not have a president. The run-off election for the top two candidates is scheduled for March 20.

Mardi Gras is March 8. Please pray especially for the church members. Maranatha Baptist Church is planning a three day retreat to help its young people through this very worldly season.

Please pray that we in the clinic will be faithful witnesses for our Lord Jesus Christ.

Jesus has shown us what obedience looks like. He does not tell us to do anything He has not already done. Rather than something to be feared, obedience brings satisfaction, joy and close communion with the Father and Son. May we be able to say with the psalmist, "*I delight to do thy will, O my God.*"(*Psalm 40:8*)
