I submitted my signature to the notary yesterday, and then paid the government tax and surveying fee for the property for the clinic project. Things move deliberately in Haiti. I should have the official papers in three weeks. We are still waiting for replies about the remaining land purchase. The placement of the gatehouse/storage depot depends on whether or not we have that land. This is the first time I have been a landowner. It seems funny that the purchase was in Haiti.

I have an appointment next Tuesday with the doctor who is in charge of rural medical development for this province. It is good to have the clinic vacation time to get some of these practical jobs done.

My plans are to return to the US on September 27, our Lord willing. There is much to do before then! The schedule for October and November is full. I look forward to meeting many of you this fall.
